- 2. The name(s) of co-author(s) and their affiliations, if any.
- 3. The tentative title. In the case of the multiple submissions, please present all of the titles with the series name.
- 4. Brief description on your paper(s). If not invited by the Editorial Board, please include new insights the author(s) provided in your paper. Also, please add a list of the important references you have surveyed.
- The expected date of the submission. In the case of multiple submissions, please specify each dates.

You will receive a notification to submit your review article after a successful initial quality review by our editorial board.

The length of the review article is assumed to be no more than 6 pages.

Note that your manuscript will be peer-reviewed by the editorial board of ABE. In addition, before

submission, you are requested to have your manuscript proofread by a professional English editing agency as mentioned in the chapter 4 of Instruction for Authors. Finally, please be advised that the Editorial Board reserves the right to request revisions and to reject the manuscript.
